It is my great privilege and pleasure to invite you in Zagreb at 11th ISIC. This School is continuation of a series of ISIC-s organized by Faculty of Chemical Engineering and Technology, University of Zagreb, Croatia, and National Institute of Chemistry, Slovenia, since 1999. The main goal of ISIC-s has always been to bring novelties from the field of ion chromatography used for both scientific and routine analysis purposes. Therefore, I am sure that each participant will find this 11th ISIC beneficial for their daily IC practice.

SCOPE

Much of the practice of ion chromatography (IC) today is well established science transformed into easily practiced technology. The number of articles on IC in Analytical Chemistry apparently reached a peak in the mid-'80s. However, the application of IC in a wide number of areas, as judged by the number of articles summarized in Chemical Abstracts, continues to grow at a healthy rate. International IC School has been providing an ideal forum in the last ten years for ion chromatographers from different regions of Balkan peninsula and neighboring countries. The reliability of IC is taken for granted today. It has become a routine tool for process analysis and control, most notably for trace analysis in the nuclear power and semiconductor industries. The practice is sufficiently widespread such that discussions on diversity of applications, qualitative and quantitative data as well as quality assurance data acquisition become extremely important that they are considered worthy of inclusion in peer reviewed literature. We find above arguments compelling enough to organize ISIC once again.

ORGANIZATION OF SEMINARS

Seminars will be organized in sessions (**lectures, poster presentations**), covering fundamentals of IC, new achievements in method development and applications. In addition, **computer supported workshop** on validation procedures (computers will be available for participant use) and **inter-laboratory proficiency test** will be organized providing valuable contribution to quality

assessment problems solution. Even though the ISIC schedule is very intensive, we shall have some opportunity to see Zagreb and share some informal moments.

CALL FOR PAPERS

Abstract for oral (2-4 pages, A4 format) and poster presentation (1 page, A4 format) should be submitted to the Secretariat before **June 15, 2010**. Abstracts of all contributing lectures will be collected in the book of abstracts which will be issued to all participants upon registration.

The abstract should have the following format:

- Single spaced using Times New Roman (12 pt)
- The title: capital letter (14 pt, bold)
- The name(s) of author(s): Surname followed by initials (12pt, bold)
- The address of authors: The full postal and e-mail address must be given (12pt, italic)

- Abstract margins should be 2,5 cm from all sides
- Dimension of poster should be 90x120 cm (W x H).
